

The Local Offer - a brief explanation

What is the Kirklees Local Offer?

From 1st September 2014 Kirklees Council is required to publish, in one place, information about the services and provisions available in our area for children and young people from birth to 25 years of age who have Special Educational Needs and/or a Disability (SEND), together with additional information about services outside of Kirklees which children and young people from our area may wish to use.

Who is producing the Local Offer?

Kirklees Council is working with parents, carers, young people, schools, colleges, early years providers and health services to produce the Local Offer.
